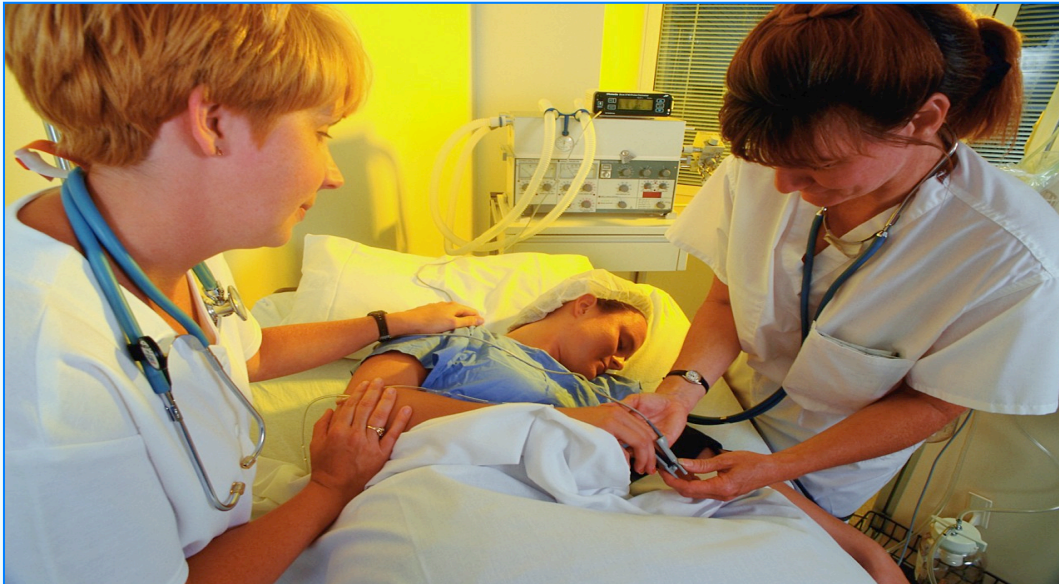
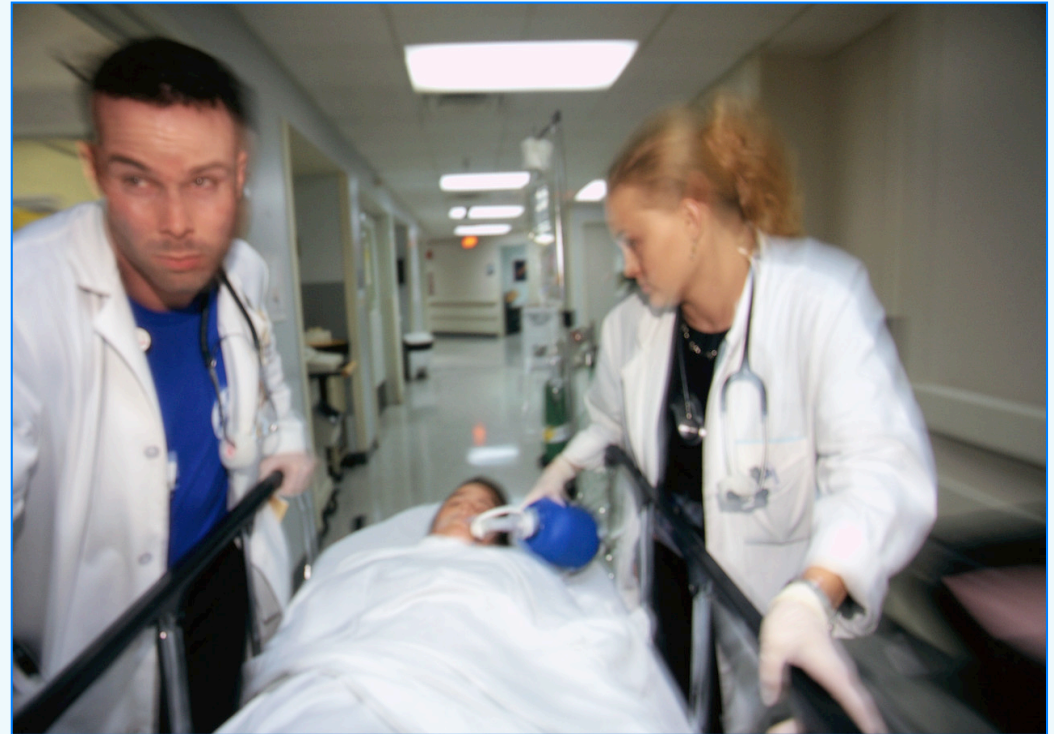

The NHS is very good at stopping people from dying.....

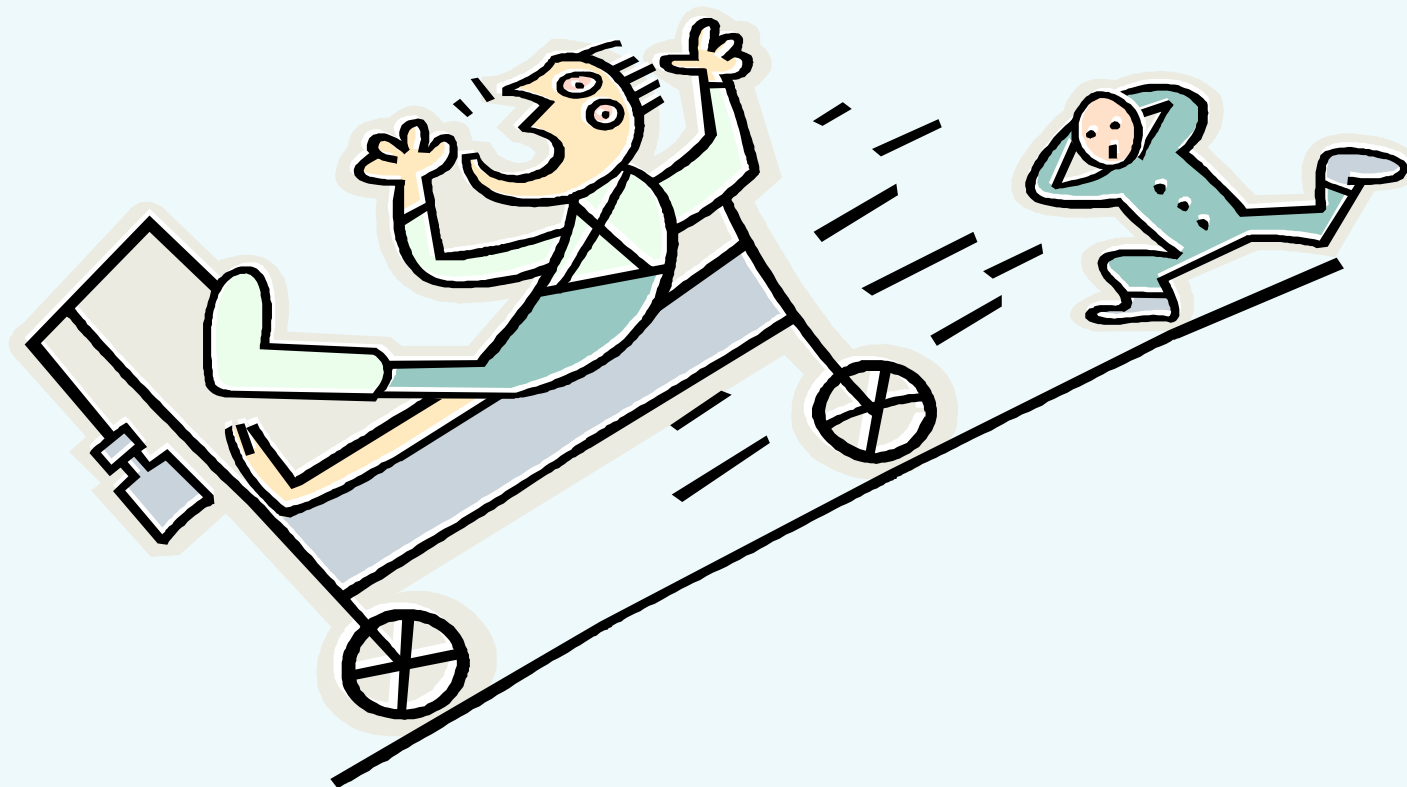

- *People should have high quality specialist services where they are needed*

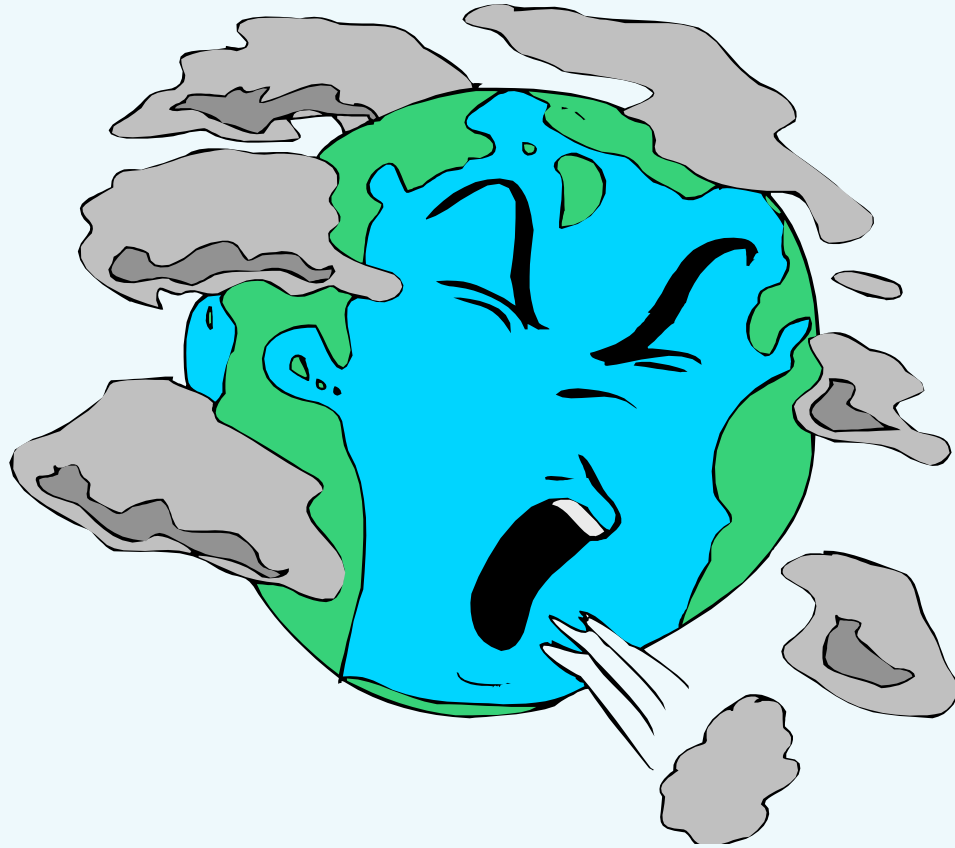

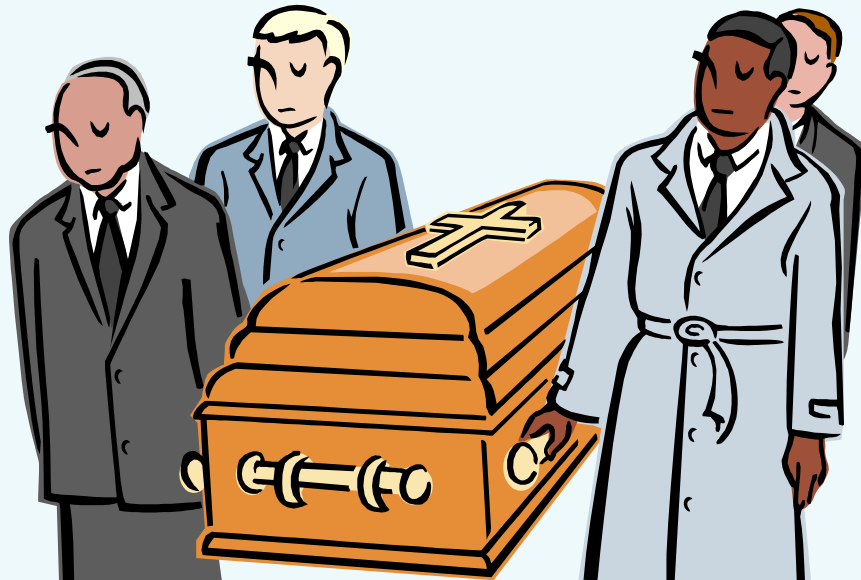

Local Actions in Place

Health checks

- ***Each person on the social services or community team list***
- ***Appointment with GP or practice nurse***
- ***Thorough health check***
 - ***physical – general***
 - ***specialist services***
- ***Payment £100 for each check***
- ***Training***
- ***Starts March 2009***



Specialist Nurse - Hospital

- *Train staff*
- *Link with families*
- *Prepare for appointments*
- *Work for smooth discharge*
- *Work with small number of people in hospitals*

Specialist Nurse – Primary Care

- *Support community staff and GPs*
- *Provide training*
- *Support health action planning*
- *Work closely with small number of cases*

Contracts – currently in negotiation

- *Health providers must show how they are making adjustments to treat people with learning disabilities differently in a positive way to improve health outcomes*
- *Must show they are making things better*
