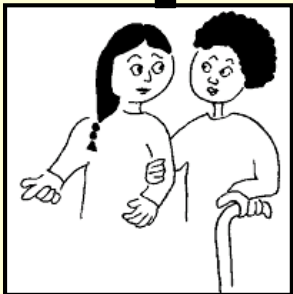
The Dignity Challenge

The Dignity Challenge



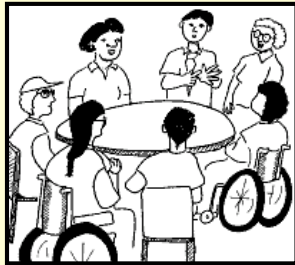
- August 2007 extended to those with mental health needs.

The Dignity Challenge



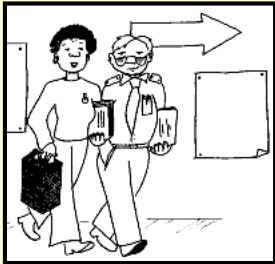
- Newcastle leads the way.

- Posters & postcards have been distributed to get positive & negative comments about services.

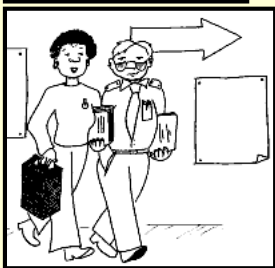
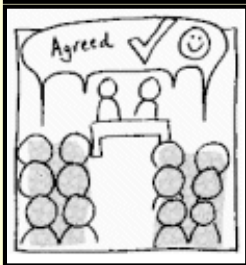
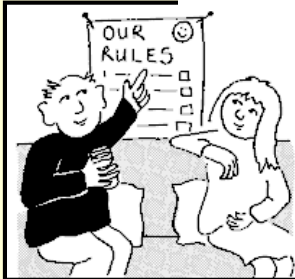
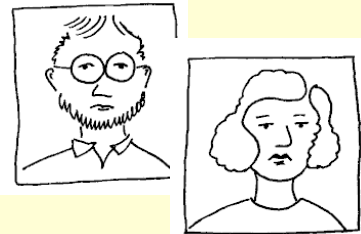
The Dignity Challenge
