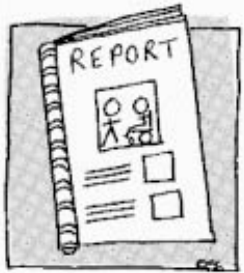

Mencap Survey 2007

- 8 in 10 People with learning disabilities experienced hate and harassment as a part of everyday life

- Training for young people

What does the new plan say?



Four Areas

- Prevention
- Engagement
- Support
- Diversion/enforcement

Prevention



includes

- Role of media
- Organisations need to do more
- Not understanding impact upon victim, families communities



Engagement



- Not knowing about ARCH
- Lack of consistency in reporting
- Lack of consistency in responding

Support

- Lack of coordination to support service
- Lack of consistency of service in some agencies
- Lack of quality control about support provided

Diversion/enforcement

- No joined up approach - to know when hate bullying becoming a real problem
- Lack of understanding ,skills, knowledge to help people working with communities to stop things getting worse
- Organisations not using powers to take action against people who commit hate crime
