

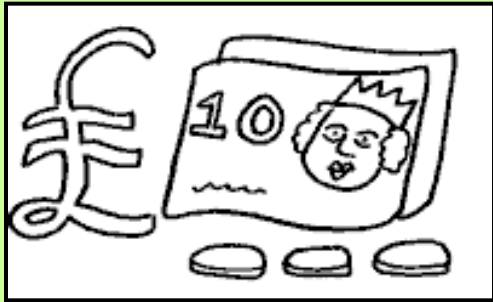

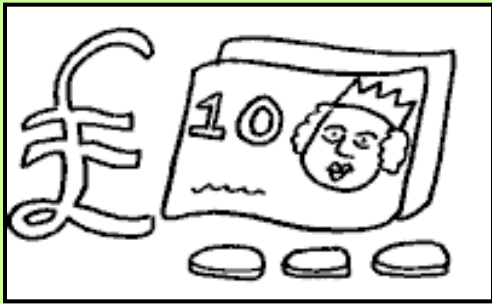


What LDDF do we have ?

Amount : £95,000

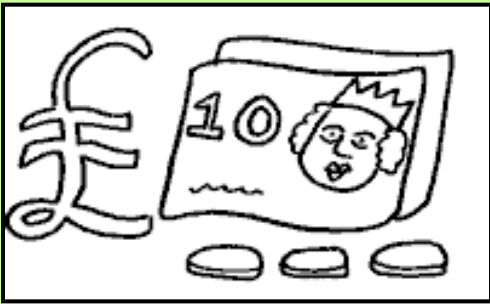
Making bids for money

- Focused
- What happens when money finishes
- One year mainly

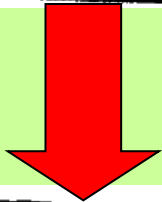




Citizens First priorities

Three Year priorities

- Making Health happen
- Growing up
- Making individual budgets happen
- Day services changes – especially around person centred reviews and people with high support needs
- All people same opportunities!



What we will ask for

- What is the Citizens First theme that this project /funding comes under?
- How important is this project to making the theme happen?
- If a theme/sub group has put in more than bid is there a preferred bid if we could only fund one?
- What will the funding be used for?
- What are the things you want from this funding (what are the outcomes you are looking for)

What we will ask for

- How will you know if the project is working? (How will you measure the success of the project?)
- How much funding is needed?
- When do you need the funding to start?
- How long do you need the LDDF for?
- When will the LDDF finish?
- Does this need to happen in 2008-09? If so, why?
- What will happen when LDDF finishes?

What we will ask for

- Will the project go on and how will it be funded?
- Are you applying for any other sources of funding bid? If you are , please tell us
- Why LDDF is the best way of funding your project?
- Sub group/theme lead endorsement

What we will think about

- Is it a clear priority for Citizens First? How important is this project to making the theme happen ?
- If a theme/sub group has put in more than bid is there a preferred bid if we could only fund one?
- Will the aims of the funding help make the theme happen?
- How valid and realistic are the outcomes and timescales
- How valid are the measures?

What we will think about

- What will happen when LDDF finishes? – is the exist strategy robust
- Sub group/theme lead endorsement - what does the theme lead /sub group think of the bid
- What would happen if we didn't fund?
- What would happen if we only funded some of it?
- What could still happen without funding?
- Are there any other pots of money we could use to fund?
- Does this need to happen in 2008-09

- Progress on those identified as Reds
- Joint Commissioning Strategy





Citizens First priorities

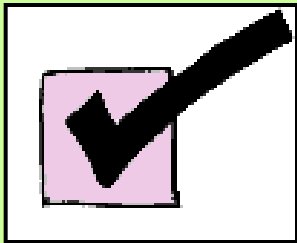
The cement of Citizens First
