

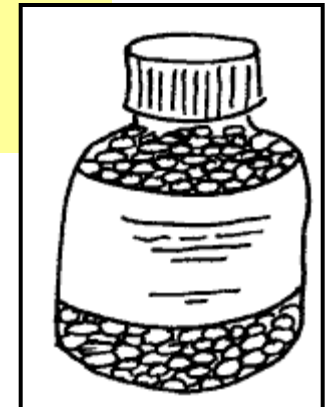

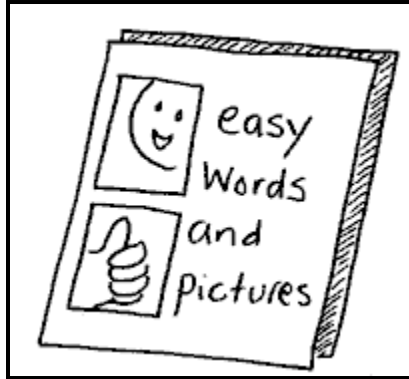

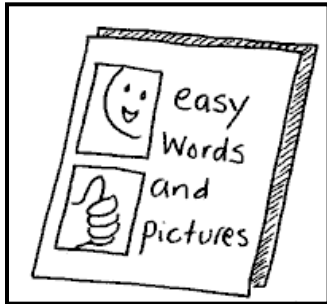


# How we will work in partnership



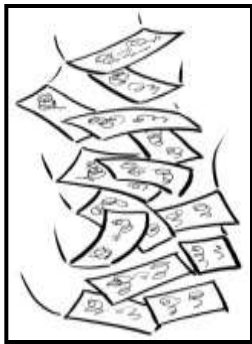
- Led by Good Health Sub Group
